LOCAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (LSI)

Rules in these Local Sailing Instructions replace or complement rules in the NoR/SI

Issued by IKA 12 March 2016

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.4 There will be a daily riders briefing at 11:00 at the official notice board except otherwise posted at the Official Notice Board, except that on 13 March 2017 the riders briefing will be at 10:00.
- 5.5 No warning signal will be made before 12:00 hours except otherwise posted on the official notice board.
- 5.6 No warning signal will be made after 1 hour before sunset.

6 FORMAT

- 6.4 The final series will consist of multiple single elimination series, half fleet or full fleet races

7 STARTING AND FINISHING

- 7.1.1 RRS F3.26 STARTING RACES is renamed to F3.26.1 START SYSTEM A (Fixed Start Line Start)
- 7.1.2 Insert new RRS F3.26.2: START SYSTEM B (Rabbit Start):

At the starting signal displayed under RRS F3.26.1 (green flag), a jetski will proceed at high speed from the start pin towards the race committee signal vessel. The wake of the jetski forms the starting line. All competitors must cross the wake of the jetski BEHIND the jetski to start.

Any competitor not crossing the starting line behind the jetski will be scored DNS without a hearing.

9 COURSES AND RACING AREAS

- 9.4 Course Marks are:

Marks 1-9:	Red inflatable triangular buoys
Finish Pin (if used):	Black/White chequered inflatable cylindrical buoy
Start Pin (if used):	Orange/White chequered inflatable cylindrical buoy
Jump Obstacles:	Yellow inflatable cylinders

11 COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

11.1 The Official Notice board is located at the judge tower.
The Official Flag Pole is located at the judge tower.

11.6 The Class Flags is WHITE:

15 EVENT SCORING

15.4 A kiteboard starting later than 1 minute after her starting signal or, when starting system B (Rabbit Start) is used 1 minute after the jetski has reached the race committee signal vessel, will be scored Did Not Start. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

18 PROTESTS, PENALTIES AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

18.5 Penalties for breaches of the ER, STR, CMG, class rules, all rules of RRS part 2, RRS 55 or rules in the NoR and SI marked [DP] or [SP], should the case go to a hearing, are at the discretion of the protest committee and may be less than disqualification.
